## M&C Stretches Energy Savings from Earth Hour to "Earth Month"

**28 March 2014** – In line with Earth Hour, Millennium & Copthorne Hotels plc (M&C) will be embarking on a month-long initiative to further reduce its carbon footprint.

Starting 29 March, the five M&C hotels in Singapore – Orchard Hotel, Grand Copthorne Waterfront Hotel, M Hotel, Studio M and Copthorne King's Hotel will aim to reduce their energy usage by 14,600 kWh. This amount of energy is able to power up the equivalent of <u>40 three-bedroom HDB flats</u> for a month. **(Annex A)** 

As part of its energy-saving efforts, M&C hotels in Singapore will be switching off the lights on the façades of its hotels, switching off water features and dimming lights in non-essential and back-of-house areas.

The M&C hotels in Singapore will also be adjusting the temperatures of some of its cooling and heating systems. The temperature of its chilled water will be raised by 2 degrees from 7 to 9 degree Celsius. Temperature settings of public air-conditioned areas will also be moved up from 23 to 25 degree Celsius. In addition, our hotels in Singapore will lower the heat pump's hot water supply temperature by 3 degree from 54 to 51 degree Celsius.

All these measures will help our Singapore hotels to meet its energy reduction target.

"In our continuing support for Earth Hour, our Singapore hotels will adopt several initiates to push for greater energy savings. By doing our part for Mother Earth, we are also rewarded with greater cash savings, which can then be invested in more energy efficient equipment," said Mr. Bhupesh Yadav, Chief Business and Administration Officer for M&C.
