HLF thwarts impersonation scam.

It can happen to anyone. Scams succeed because they look like the real thing and catch you off guard when you are not expecting it. With the number of reported scam cases on the rise, it is important to be alert, stay calm, know who you are dealing with, and keep your personal details secure.

Hong Leong Finance shares a real-life case that happened to one of their customers.

The top priority at Hong Leong Finance (HLF) is to ensure a safe and trusted banking environment for all customers. Initiatives like website alerts warn customers of scam calls and voice phishing. HLF educates customers how to spot signs of threats at their branches and various customer touch points. A Fraud Awareness Team was also set up to keep employees updated with lessons that can be learnt from different scam cases. The following is an example of such a case.

Vigilant staff thwarts impersonation scam

Madam Neo (not her real name) received a call from a foreign number with a prefix +86 on her mobile phone. The caller claimed to be an Investigation Officer from China and said cards had been used overseas by criminals. Claiming to aid in the investigation, the caller told Madam Neo they were required by authorities to report their daily whereabouts and consolidate their savings into a single bank account. The caller then proceeded to instruct her to transfer her funds into one account.

Madam Neo panicked. She went to HLF's Hougang Branch and requested to withdraw all her fixed deposits (FD) into one savings account so she can give it to "him". When probed who is "he" and the reason to withdraw her FDs prematurely, she was vague and elusive but remained insistent on the withdrawal.

The team at the branch is familiar with Madam Neo's transactional pattern. They knew she did not need excessive funds and always renewed her FDs upon maturity. Coupled with her unusual behaviour, they were immediately on the alert. They immediately suspected that she was a victim of a scam, contacted her next-of-kin to make further checks, and finally lodged a police report.



Madam Neo's accounts were also promptly put on hold, and HLF was able to safeguard her from falling prey to scammers and prevent monetary loss.


6 Tips To Prevent Scams

- **1. Spot the signs:** Recognise the tactics that scammers use.
- **2. Stop and think:** Ask yourself or others if a statement, message or job offer could be true.
- **3. Slow down, don't rush:** Do not rush into providing your personal or banking details.
- **4. Speak to others:** Check with others to verify the authenticity of a claim before doing anything.
- **5. Safeguard personal details and passwords**: Never disclose personal information, even if the request appears to be legitimate.
- **6. Seek help:** Talk to friends or family members for advice or support if you have been impacted by a scam.

A stunning new addition was made to the Duncan Edwards Room at Dudley's Copthorne Hotel when a replica of the stained-glass window in St Francis Church was unveiled.

The event was hosted by Jim Cadman, chairman of Duncan Edwards United, who for the past 20 years has worked on keeping the Manchester United and England footballer's legacy alive in the Black Country and beyond.




Also present at the unveiling were artist Steve Melgie Merry, Duncan's cousin Betty Cooksey, Revd Canon Hugh Burton, the Rector of Dudley, members of the Manchester Munich Memorial Foundation and team-mates from Edwards' schooldays.

The original stained-glass window at St Francis Church shows Edwards memorialised in United and England kit with the words 'God is with us for our Captain' and 'Though there be many members yet is there one body' adorning ribbons across his chest. Underneath the depiction of Edwards in United's red and white kit, an inscription reads: 'Thanking God for the Life of Duncan Edwards, died at Munich, February 1958.'

The late Duncan Edwards is widely regarded as one of the greatest footballers of all time, but his career tragically ended when he became a victim of the Munich air disaster in February 1958 that claimed the lives of 23 on board, including eight Manchester United Football Club (MUFC) players. He was aged 21.

The football world came together in grief and support of United, who lost eight players, and St Francis Church, which is located on the Priory estate where Edwards spent his childhood, made an appeal for Football League sides to help finance a stained-glass memorial to their local hero.

Manchester United, Brentford, Crystal Palace and Wrens Nest Bowling Club responded to the plea and their individual crests are incorporated into the window, which was unveiled in 1961 by Sir Matt Busby, United's manager at the time of the tragedy.

Hugh Burton said: "I am fortunate to see the original stained-glass window most days and it was remarkable to view the craftsmanship and likeness of the replica to the original.

"We will continue to welcome visitors to St Francis Church to see the original window but this new installation gives hotel visitors the chance to find out more about Duncan's life and career.

"The unveiling was also an opportunity to meet the dedicated people connected with Duncan Edwards United and I look forward to working with them to help keep his legacy alive."

Phase One to open in Nov 2022

Jungceylon Mall will be embarking on a revamp after 15 years of operation. Located in the heart of Patong, Phuket in Thailand, the new mall is conceptualised as the "Oasis of Patong" and will boast a range of exciting new lifestyle attractions as Phuket's shopping paradise.

Jungceylon, one of Phuket's largest malls in the vibrant Patong neighbourhood, is preparing to undergo major renovation works from 2022 to 2023, transforming the mall into the Oasis of Patong. The mall will be a one-stop shopping paradise encompassing fresh and immersive concepts that will enhance the shopping experience in this lively and convenient locale.

The first phase, The Botanica is scheduled to open in November 2022.

"Since opening its doors 15 years ago, Jungceylon has been a shopping and leisure landmark in Phuket," said Mr. Prawit Janyasitthikul, Chief Executive Officer of Phuket Square Co. Ltd. which manages Jungceylon.

"As one of the first few retail malls to open in Phuket, Jungceylon has played a key role in modernising the Patong area. In pre-pandemic times, the mall welcomed over 17 million shoppers annually. This year, the company has prepared a major two-phase renovation plan throughout the shopping centre, covering over 55 rai or approximately 200,000 square metres. In the first phase, the mall's interior will undergo upgrading works at all the zones. The target reopening of the mall, following the completion of the first phase, is in the fourth quarter of 2022. For the second phase, works will be carried out to the external façade with the official opening slated for December 2023," he said.



Mr. Prawit Janyasitthikul, Chief Executive Officer of Phuket Square Co. Ltd. which manages Jungceylon, said the makeover will mark a significant asset enhancement initiative since the mall opened in 2006.

New concept and attractions

Describing the new concept, Mr Prawitt said, "With the revamp, we will transform Jungceylon into a shopping oasis in Patong. In line with our vision of a new shopping experience in the heart of Patong, the mall's interiors will be embraced by lush greenery, and shoppers will enjoy a relaxed, comfortable and fresh environment. Beautiful gardens and big fountains inside the shopping centre will harmoniously combine naturalness with architecture in the perfect form of a 'Tropical Resort Mall'. The nature theme will cover four zones: The Jungle, The Bay, The Botanica, and The Garden, which will house new stores and services, including a cluster of fashion shops, family restaurants and spots for hangouts."



First phase of the revamp, The Botanica (pictured above) is one of four zones in Jungceylon's brand new concept that will house an adventure park, a hypermarket, cinema, Robinsons department store, and more. It is scheduled to open in November 2022.

New attractions will also be added to enliven the spaces.

- LOVE EAT: This new restaurant zone is decorated in the style of a courthouse, blending nature and culture perfectly. Spanning an area of over 3,000 square metres, it will introduce a unique "Digital Delicious" experience, where the real and the virtual worlds meet a first in Thailand under the EAT & PLAY concept. Serving innovative digital dining experiences that combine the science of fine dining cooking with the art of technology beyond imagination and the technique of blending information from the real world and the virtual world, this Sensory Experience will showcase internationally recognised works across all dimensions.
- **Digital Amusement:** Spread across more than 2,000 square metres of space, this interactive digital show is the is the first in Thailand. It will convey experiences through mixed reality and virtual world technology. Visitors can experience the fun and excitement in digital art through different concepts in each exhibition area. For instance, at the Culture Zone, Thailand's traditions, arts and culture will be showcased in a unique digital light show. There will also be zones for Art, Fashion, Adventure, Games, and more.
- Tourist Service Centre: A new one-stop service centre for tourists, offering information and other services such as the booking of taxi services, airport shuttle bus, air ticket reservations, advance airline check-in, currency exchange services, mobile phone and internet SIM sales points, luggage storage services, and others.

With its plethora of offerings, the company expects Jungceylon to be a must-visit shopping destination for both locals and tourists in the heart of Phuket.

City Developments Limited (CDL) holds a 49% interest in the mixed-use development that comprises Jungceylon Shopping Mall and Millennium Resort Patong Phuket. They are located in the commercial area of Patong, Phuket Island in Thailand.

Copen Grand

Jointly developed by CDL and joint venture partner, MCL Land, the 639-unit Executive Condominium (EC) project will be in Tengah Town - Singapore's first smart and sustainable precinct. The project is within walking distance of three upcoming MRT stations along the Jurong Region Line and is near the Jurong Innovation District and Jurong Lake District. Designed with sustainability in mind, the project is the first Building and Construction Authority (BCA) Green Mark Platinum Super Low Energy EC in Singapore.

Expected launch: Q4 2022





Newport Residences

Formerly known as Fuji Xerox Towers, freehold project Newport Residences (estimated 246 residential units) will be part of a mixed-use development with commercial space and serviced apartments named Newport Plaza and Newport Tower respectively. Located in the heart of Singapore's Central Business District in Tanjong Pagar, transportation is a breeze via Anson Road and Keppel Road, several MRT stations and various amenities nearby.

Expected launch: 1H 2023



798 & 800 Upper Bukit Timah Road

With about 408 units, the 99-year leasehold project is a hop and skip away from Cashew MRT station. Future residents will find it a breeze to commute across all parts of Singapore via the station's Downtown Line. The Bukit Timah area is a highly sought-after private residential address by many investors and by many investors and Singaporeans with bungalows, high-end condominiums and reputable schools in the area.

Jalan Tembusu

Located near the upcoming Tanjong Katong MRT Station, this 99-year leasehold project is estimated to have about 638 units with popular schools like Tanjong Katong Primary School and Canadian International School in the vicinity. A childcare centre will be available onsite. Residents will also enjoy nearby parks and nature reserves, commercial, F&B and retail options, and a supermarket across the road.

K Parcel

Located along Flora Drive, this 280-unit freehold development along Flora Drive (in front of The Jovell) will be the latest residential project by Tripartite Developers (HLHL, CDL and TID). The site is located near the new Tampines East MRT Station with easy access to Changi Airport, Changi Business Park, Downtown East, and expressways to the city. Nearby amenities include Tampines Mall, Loyang Point, White Sands Mall, Giant supermarket and IKEA.

CDL Awarded GLS Site At Bukit Batok West Ave 5

CDL was recently awarded the Bukit Batok West Avenue 5 EC site and will be exploring a project comprising around 510 residential units and a basement carpark.

City Developments Limited (CDL) made a successful bid for a 99-year leasehold executive condominium (EC) site at Bukit Batok West Avenue 5, a well-established District 23 residential enclave. CDL's bid of \$336,068,000 (or \$626 psf ppr) topped the keenly contested tender by a razor-thin margin of 0.2% (\$1 psf ppr) versus the second highest bid, amongst a total of four bids.

Mr Sherman Kwek, CDL Group Chief Executive Officer, said, "We are very pleased to emerge as the top bidder for this tightly contested EC site in Bukit Batok West, especially at such a narrow margin of victory. Given the site's proximity to the upcoming Tengah New Town and Jurong Lake District, it will benefit from easy access to a wide range of amenities as well as good connectivity to such a key business, lifestyle and tourism hub. We look forward to transforming this expansive site into a sustainably designed and well-built residential landmark."

The expansive 178,936 square feet (sq ft) site with a plot ratio of 3.0 is located at the junction of Bukit Batok West Avenue 5 and Bukit Batok Road, opposite the upcoming Tengah New Town, which will have amenities such as a community club, a polyclinic and an integrated bus interchange. The site is conveniently located between three MRT stations – Bukit Gombak MRT station on the North-South Line, and the upcoming Tengah Plantation and Tengah Park MRT stations on the Jurong Region Line (expected to be ready around 2028).

Nearby amenities such as Le Quest Mall, Market & Food Centre at Bukit Batok Street 11, Hong Kah North Community Club as well as Bukit Gombak Sports Centre and Stadium provide comprehensive shopping, dining and recreation options.

CDL was awarded the site on 28 September and plans to explore an EC project comprising 10 blocks of 12 to 13 storeys with around 510 residential units and a basement carpark. This project will be designed to achieve the BCA Green Mark Platinum (Super Low Energy) rating, in line with CDL's pledge to reach net-zero carbon emissions by 2030.

TID, a joint venture between Hong Leong Holdings and Mitsui Fudosan, emerged as the top bidder for Lentor Hills Road (Parcel B). TID submitted a bid of S\$276.36 million, which works out to S\$1,130 psf per plot ratio (psf ppr).

According to analysts, TID's bid was 18.9% higher than the S\$950 psf ppr bid submitted by one other bidder. A total of two bids were received for the land parcel.

The 99-year leasehold Lentor Hills Road (Parcel B) site, which spans 116,455 sq ft, can yield about 495 residential units. It is located within the new Lentor Hills Estate which is envisioned as a sustainable and pedestrian-friendly neighbourhood amidst lush greenery.

Located in close proximity to the new Lentor MRT Station on the Thomson-East Coast Line, future residents will enjoy direct access via public transport to Woodlands Regional Centre, the Central Business District and various parts of Singapore. Established schools such as Presbyterian High School, Anderson Primary School, and CHIJ St Nicholas Girls' School are located nearby. Future residents can look forward to retail options, a supermarket and childcare facilities located within the upcoming mixed-use development at Lentor Modern and enjoy lush greenery and recreation choices at the future hillock and linear parks nearby.

The site was awarded to TID on 19 September 2022.



Organised by CDL, around 85 directors, senior management and staff across the Hong Leong Group of companies attended the 9th Annual Sustainability Forum for Hong Leong Group.

On 4 Oct 2022, City Developments Limited (CDL) held its 9th Annual Sustainability Forum for CDL and the Hong Leong Group of companies virtually over zoom. An annual event co-organised by the Group Corporate Secretariat Services and CDL's Sustainability department since 2014, the Annual Sustainability Forum aims to align the Group's directors and senior management with latest sustainability trends and best practices.

Aptly themed 'Zero in on Future Value: Turning Risks to Growth Opportunities', the business community is in the position to accelerate action to decarbonise their business practices and products. The forum proved to be timely with the third and final instalment of the IPCC's Sixth Assessment Report published earlier this year in April 2022, which found that average annual global greenhouse gas emissions were at their highest levels in human history between 2010 to 2019, but the rate of growth of emissions has since slowed. With this, the business case for sustainability integration and reporting has never been stronger, and there is an ever-urgent need for global Race to Zero, to turn risks into business advantages and growth opportunities.

Around 85 directors, senior management and staff of the Hong Leong and CDL Group of Companies attended the forum. 
Dr Loh shared best practices in sustainability governance and strategy from Case of Climate Reporting.

A "breathtaking sight" greeted Member of Parliament Jamus Lim of Sengkang Group Representation Constituency during one of his house visits this week. He had uploaded a video of the garden in a Facebook post on Friday (March 4), which garnered many positive responses.

Mr Lim wrote: "For me, the project is an example of what can happen when neighbours get along, and make a concerted effort to improve their surroundings. Living in shared spaces tends to require some give and take. And when neighbours are able to come together, the result can be extraordinary."

It all started with one painting of a waterfall surrounded by flowers that Ms Mary Aw hung in the common area outside her flat. She did it so residents will "see the greens and feel serene" when they throw their rubbish in the common rubbish chute. Gradually she added more paintings after receiving compliments and encouragement from the residents. There are now 16 pieces along the corridor.

Ms Aw's love for plants

The corridor is also filled with plants. An avid plant lover since young, Ms Aw would tend to the plants every morning – watering them, checking their condition, adding fertiliser and trimming them when needed. She would also regularly clean the area to prevent it from getting dirty with plant debris or fallen leaves.

It was actually by chance that the grandmother of five started learning acrylic painting in July 2021. She had originally bought the painting materials for her grandchildren, but discovered that she enjoyed it immensely when she decided to try her hand at it as well.

She particularly enjoys landscape pieces such as flowers, trees and rivers, and began painting two to three times a week, finding it also a therapeutic process. She has painted over 200 pieces since her 'accidental' passion was discovered a year ago.

I consulted another close colleague in Hong Leong Holdings on my desire to contribute with all proceeds donated to Assisi Hospice. She requested anonymity but instantly volunteered to partner me in this initiative and funded all the art materials required for this cause. With her support and encouragement, I began painting in early September and finished 54 pieces of artwork.

The paintings are priced from S\$38 to S\$288 each and comes in different styles and dimensions. Some appreciative buyers, including senior management across the Hong Leong Group companies, donated S\$300 to S\$500 apiece. I am grateful that I have pre-sold over 90% of my paintings ahead of the Assisi fundraiser and raised more than S\$6,000 for the good cause.

I sincerely appreciate my colleague's financial support for making this a reality. Who knew that this little passion of mine can turn into such a worthwhile contribution to the community!


