The Astor Grill Takes Permanent Residences At The St. Regis Singapore

The Astor Grill's steaks are cooked on a custom-built parrilla grill.

The Astor Grill is now a permanent fixture at The St. Regis Singapore following a successful three-month trial pop-up that ran from June to August at the hotel. It takes the space of the former Brasserie Les Saveurs at the lobby.

The grill concept is helmed by Chef de Cuisine Angelo Sergio with more than 20 years mastery in steakhouses, and well-equipped with butchery, dry ageing, curing and grilling skills.

Under him, the menu has expanded with new primary cuts, such as the 500 days grain-fed full-blood autumn wagyu striploin (\$138 for 250g) and 450 days grain-fed bone-in New York striploin (\$158 for 500g), a cross-breed of Australian and Japanese wagyu.

There are also new non-beef options as well, such as starters of grilled Spanish octopus (\$36), grilled Kurobuta pork chop (\$52) and grilled Boston lobster (\$108 for 550g).

Inspired by the heritage of St. Regis with culinary craft that harks closely to the landscape of original great chophouses set in the early century New York (where the first St. Regis was established), The Astor Grill celebrates quality cuts of exceptional eminence, as well as bespoke dining experiences of storied legacy and rituals from the House of Astor.

In Liverpool With
Hard Days Night
Hotel Taking
Centre Stage

This was the night of The Beatles' famous appearance at the Royal Variety Performance on 4 November 1963, in the presence of the late Queen Mother and Princess Margaret at the Prince of Wales Theatre in London. It was a significant moment of pride for the Fab Four and Liverpool, their birthplace.

The city of Liverpool is the proud birthplace that revolves around one of their own, The Beatles, the most successful band in rock history.

The significant moment for the city came on the night of 4 November 1963 when the Fab Four – John Lennon, Paul McCartney, George Harrison and Ringo Starr – made their famous appearance at the Royal Variety Performance, in the presence of the late Queen Mother and Princess Margaret at the Prince of Wales Theatre in London. It was a proud moment not only for the boys, but also for Liverpool as it reflected how one of their own has become a successful and respectable worldwide phenomenon.

Hard Days Night Hotel: The Beatles here, there and everywhere

It is here that Hard Days Night Hotel takes centre stage, the only Beatles-themed hotel in the world. Named after their famous song, "A Hard Day's Night", the hotel is housed in a huge 1884 building with rooms and public areas decorated with Beatles-inspired artwork. Let's take a little journey through The Beatles' universe to get to the hotel.



From London, one can easily get to Liverpool by train arriving at Lime Street Station, or simply fly direct to the city of the Beatles and land at the Liverpool John Lennon Airport.



From Lime Street, it is a 15-minute walk to Hard Days Night Hotel which is housed in a huge 1884 building. The hotel is the only Beatles-themed hotel in the world.



A statue of John Lennon stands at the facade of the hotel.



Furnished with a white baby grand piano, the John Lennon Suite is filled with tasteful memorabilia including a portrait of John Lennon himself, and a large private balcony offering spectacular city views.



Blakes Restaurant is the hotel's flagship restaurant named after Sir Peter Blake, who designed the iconic sleeve for the Sgt Peppers Lonely Hearts Club Band album. The all-day dining restaurant boasts wall-to-wall original Beatles-themed artwork.



The Bar at Hard Days Night Hotel is undoubtedly one of the must visit bars in Liverpool city centre with a chic and stylish vibe. The reference to the Beatles is even in the smallest details where one can even order the drink, "Strawberry Fields with Pepper".

Hong Leong Asia (HLA) recently hosted a group of visiting delegates from Saudi Arabia as part of their visit to meet with built environment companies in Singapore.

The delegation of industry participants, led by the National Development Division at Public Investment Fund, visited HL-Sunway Prefab Hub, the latest state-of-the-art manufacturing facility in Singapore, and was able to see first-hand the integration of precast concrete automation technologies with green features which will not only improve the supply chain resiliency of construction projects but also enhance the quality of precast components.

During the visit, Mr Patrick Yau, HLA Chief Investment Officer, Mr Simon Loh, Chief Operating Officer of HLA's Building Materials Group and the R3 Precast team, met with representatives from Saudi Arabia companies, Red Sea Global, Qiddiya, Rua Al Madinah, Diriyah, Roshn Development, NEOM and New Murabba, to discuss automated precast manufacturing techniques with a presentation to the delegation members.

Initiated by Enterprise SG, the Saudi Arabian delegation's visit presents an opportunity for Hong Leong Asia to showcase its capabilities and portfolio of industry-leading businesses in the build environment industry.

HLA also shared how it contributes and exchange with value-chain players in developing industry expertise towards integrating greener practices, and optimise productivity and efficiency in the region and beyond.

UK Private
Rented Sector
Portfolio With
Acquisition Of
Manchester
Project 1NQ

Named 1NQ, the 261-unit freehold Manchester project will mark CDL's fourth PRS project in the UK since 2019. (artist's impression)

City Developments Limited (CDL) has expanded its United Kingdom (UK) Private Rented Sector (PRS) portfolio with the acquisition of 1NQ, a 261-unit freehold project in Manchester for £75.6 million (approximately S\$125.7 million). CDL will forward-fund the PRS project, which is currently under development.

The site is located near Piccadilly Station, along Tariff Street and Port Street in the Northern Quarter, within the Piccadilly Basin neighbourhood of Manchester. Full planning permission was obtained in October 2023. CDL plans to develop the site into two new-build 10 and 12-storey apartment blocks housing a mix of 1-, 2- and 3-bedroom apartments and two commercial units on the ground floor. The project is expected to be completed in 2026.

1NQ is the Group's fourth PRS project in the UK since 2019. The first was CDL's acquisition of the development site for a 665-unit project in Leeds called The Junction. This was followed by another two acquisitions in 2021 – one by CDL Hospitality Trusts (CDLHT), the Group's REIT associate, a 352-unit forward-funded project in Manchester named The Castings, and the other project by CDL called The Octagon in Birmingham, with 370 units.

Mr Sherman Kwek, CDL Group Chief Executive Officer, said, "Despite an uncertain macroeconomic environment, our PRS assets have shown resilience and strong growth potential. We have continued to scale up our global living sector portfolio to drive growth in our recurring income. This year, our Group's global PRS portfolio has grown by almost 70% to 4,489 operational and pipeline units in the UK, Japan, Australia and the US, up from 2,640 units last year. 1NQ marks CDL's first UK PRS acquisition under a forward-funding arrangement, which enables us to secure our investment at a fixed cost, manage our cash flows over the development period and benefit from potential capital appreciation."

The 1NQ site is near numerous amenities such as cafes, bars, restaurants, gyms and independent retailers. It is an 8-minute walk to Piccadilly Station and a 14-minute walk to Victoria Station. The site is one of the last few residential sites available for development in the Northern Quarter, ranked by Time Out magazine as "one of the coolest neighbourhoods on earth" in 2022. The Northern Quarter is one of Manchester's liveliest neighbourhoods and is popular with young professionals.

A bustling place for startups, creatives and digital companies by day, the neighbourhood transforms into a leisure scene at night with restaurants, bars, pop-up events and live music.

As the second largest city in the UK outside of London, Manchester has a relatively young population. Greater Manchester is also home to five major universities and has the best graduate retention rate of 51% amongst all the UK regional cities.





CDL And JV Partner Galliard Homes Acquires London's Morden Wharf

CDL and joint venture partner Galliard Homes, a leading UK residential and mixed-use developer, has acquired the 13.8 acre Morden Wharf development in the Royal Borough of Greenwich, located in southeast Greater London, England.

The joint venture partnership between CDL and leading UK residential and mixed-use developer Galliard Homes, has completed the acquisition of the 13.8-acre Morden Wharf development in the Royal Borough of Greenwich in southeast Greater London.

The partnership acquired the site from LandsecU+I and the Morden College charity, with hybrid planning permission secured in September 2022 for a residential-led mixed-use scheme. The proposed development will comprise 12 blocks up to 36 storeys, delivering around 1,500 new residential units with stunning 360° views that overlook iconic landmarks such as the River Thames, Canary Wharf, and The Old Royal Naval College in Greenwich.

The Morden Wharf development will include 186,000 square feet (sq ft) of commercial floor space, which can accommodate logistics, industrial, and flexible creative workspace units. The site will feature 50,000 sq ft of retail, restaurant, community, and convenience spaces, fostering a vibrant and well-rounded community atmosphere.

It will also boast a 275-metre riverside frontage with an enhanced Thames Path, and a unique 3.9-acre riverside park with ample green spaces. A riverside pier will provide access to the new Uber Boat by Thames Clippers service, adding transportation options in the area.

This acquisition marks the first partnership between Galliard Homes and CDL, bringing together two leading developers with over 90 years of combined experience and strong expertise in delivering sustainable developments within which communities can flourish and grow.

Mr Stephen Conway, Executive Chairman at Galliard Homes, says: "Galliard Homes is delighted to announce our partnership with CDL, to provide much-needed homes within Greenwich. CDL's worldwide reputation as an industry leader, marked by their commitment to delivering first-class development across numerous asset classes, aligns with our values. We hope this will be the first of many more future projects together. We thank LandsecU+I and Morden College for their active support and collaboration. We look forward to turning their exciting plans into a new landmark scheme for London".

CDL And CDLHT Report Operational Updates For 3Q 2023

CDL's Q3 sales rise to S\$325m on launch of The Myst, a 408-unit residential development located in Upper Bukit Timah Road.

City Developments Limited (CDL)

In Q3 2023, CDL Group and its joint venture (JV) associates sold 183 units with a total sales value of S\$325 million (Q3 2022: 95 units with a total sales value of S\$281 million). Sales were largely driven by the launch of The Myst in July.

For the first nine months ended 30 September 2023 (YTD Sep 2023), the Group and its JV associates sold 691 units with a total sales value of S\$1.4 billion (YTD Sep 2022: 802 units with a total sales value of S\$1.9 billion). Private residential property prices showed resilience despite macroeconomic concerns, achieving moderate growth in Q3 2023.

The Group's hotels continued a strong recovery momentum. Global Revenue Per Available Room (RevPAR) rose 31.6% to S\$163.6 for YTD Sep 2023 (YTD Sep 2022: S\$124.3). All regions achieved a higher RevPAR, with Asia and Australasia showing the greatest improvement, increasing 62.1% and 67.5% respectively. RevPAR for YTD Sep 2023 also exceeded YTD Sep 2019 levels by 20.0%, attributed mainly to higher room rates.

As at 30 September 2023, the Group's net gearing ratio (after factoring in fair value on investment properties) stands at 58%, following the completion of various acquisitions in 2023, including St Katharine Docks, two hotels and several PRS assets.

CDL Hospitality Trusts (CDLHT)

CDLHT achieved a strong year-on-year ("yoy") improvement in performance in 3Q 2023, which reflects the continued recovery in international travel. RevPAR growth was recorded across most portfolio markets, with seven hotels having achieved their highest 3Q RevPAR. CDLHT's 3Q 2023 gross revenue grew by 19.7% (or S\$11.6 million) yoy to S\$70.1 million, of which S\$6.0 million of the increase was contributed by its Singapore Hotels. In tandem with the higher revenue, net property income ("NPI") increased by 23.3% (or S\$7.4 million) yoy to S\$39.0 million for 3Q 2023.



Enhancements to the public areas of W Singapore -Sentosa Cove were completed substantially in 3Q 2023.

For the first nine months ended 30 September 2023, CDLHT's gross revenue increased by 20.4% (or \$\$32.1 million) yoy to \$\$189.3 million, of which \$\$21.7 million and \$\$11.9 million of the increase was attributed to the Singapore Hotels and the overseas portfolio (excluding the New Zealand Hotel) respectively. The improvement was partially offset by lower contribution from the New Zealand Hotel, following the reversion to public trading from 2Q 2022 onwards, after its exit from the government isolation programme.

In tandem with the increased revenue, NPI increased by 23.3% (or S\$19.3 million) yoy to S\$101.9 million for YTD Sep 2023. The higher NPI was largely attributed to the Singapore, Germany, Italy and Japan portfolios, which increased collectively by S\$21.5 million yoy. This improvement includes higher NPI from Claymore Connect, which increased by 63.9% or S\$1.6 million. These increases were partly offset by lower NPI from the New Zealand Hotel and Maldives Resorts, which declined collectively by S\$3.7 million yoy for YTD Sep 2023.

The Managers continue to explore investment opportunities through asset enhancements. Grand Copthorne Waterfront Hotel, a major asset, has completed the full renovation of all of its rooms and meeting spaces, solidifying its position as a leading conference hotel in Singapore for years to come. Enhancements to the public areas of W Hotel are substantively completed while that of Grand Millennium Auckland are ongoing, which will augment their competitive standing in the respective markets.

Liebherr-Components together with Guangxi Yuchai Marine and Genset Power Co., Ltd recently celebrated ten years of successful partnership on the manufacturing and distribution of high-performance engines for on- and off-road applications in China. The collaboration extends across the high-performance off-highway and large engine sectors as well as alternative powertrain solutions with significant joint developments in the field of propulsion technology.

In August 2013, both companies initiated their first joint project, the development of the 6-cylinder in-line diesel engine, 6TD, used in Genset applications. In the following years, the partnership expanded to include additional engine platforms in the high-performance sector and the diesel large engine domain to respond to the changing needs in drive technology and emission reduction.

For example in 2022, the first firing of the Yuchai hydrogen engine equipped with a Liebherr injection solution reflects their joint capacity for innovation and technological excellence in eco-friendly propulsion solutions.

"Yuchai and Liebherr are two powerful companies that, over the past ten years, have jointly delivered powerful products to the market. Together, we have mastered all previous challenges and are also facing the new demands of drive technology with the same determination," said Mr Richard Pirkl, Managing Director of fuel injection technology and development at Liebherr-Components Deggendorf GmbH.

CDL Secures Singapore's First Net Zero-Aligned Loan Towards A Low-Carbon Economy

City Developments Limited is the first corporate in Singapore to obtain the OCBC 1.5°C sustainability-linked loan.

City Developments Limited (CDL) marks a new sustainable financing milestone as the first corporate to obtain the OCBC 1.5°C loan, with interest rate incentives pegged to annual decarbonisation performance targets. The three-year £200 million (approximately S\$338.2 million) sustainability-linked revolving credit facility (RCF) will be utilised for refinancing, general corporate funding and working capital purposes.

The 1.5°C loan provided by OCBC is a new financing solution launched earlier this year to incentivise corporates to set and work towards clear carbon emissions reduction targets aligned with internationally recognised, science-based net-zero decarbonisation pathways for their sectors. When the annual targets are met or exceeded, corporates will get a reduced interest rate on their loans. The reference pathways, developed by autonomous global organisations, are geared towards achieving a net zero level of greenhouse gas emissions (GHG) by 2050 to limit global warming to 1.5°C above pre-industrial levels.

The sustainability-linked loan is aligned with CDL's commitment to achieve operational net zero by 2030 for its new and existing wholly-owned assets and developments under its direct operational and management control, with the entire portfolio achieving operational net zero by 2050. As part of the loan terms, CDL will enjoy interest rate reductions upon meeting the pre-agreed annual decarbonisation performance targets, in line with CDL's Science Based Targets initiative (SBTi)-validated targets of a reduction in GHG emissions intensity by 63% per square metre leased area (Scope 1 and 2), 41% per square metre gross floor area (Scope 3 GHG emissions from purchased goods and services) and 58.8% including hotels managed by CDL's wholly-owned hotel subsidiary, Millennium & Copthorne Hotels Limited (Scope 3 GHG emissions from investments), against its 2016 baseline, by 2030. The performance measurements will be externally assured.

In 2022, CDL achieved a 24% reduction in carbon emissions intensity, against its baseline year. It achieved a 10% reduction in total operational carbon emissions across all its business operations in Singapore compared to 2021 as well as a 22% reduction in embodied carbon of building materials compared to the conventional equivalents.

Ms Yiong Yim Ming, Group Chief Financial Officer, CDL, said: "We are delighted to partner OCBC in this new financing solution that allocates capital to support climate action and achieve measurable decarbonisation impact. This first-of-its-kind sustainability-linked loan directly incentivises decarbonisation performance and reflects our focus on aligning our capital management matrix with our sustainability commitment. Since 2017, we have embarked on alternative financing avenues to channel capital towards building smarter, greener and more climate-friendly infrastructure. With rising investor expectations and a global shift to a low-carbon economy, we will continue to explore more sustainable financing initiatives aimed at developing green buildings that enhance our emissions pathways to reach our decarbonisation targets. By aligning finance with sustainability, the investment community and corporates can collectively mobilise capital towards delivering positive impact."

Ms Elaine Lam, Head of Global Corporate Banking, OCBC, said: "We are pleased to partner CDL on the first OCBC 1.5°C loan. Ranked by Corporate Knights as the world's most sustainable real estate management and development company and Singapore's most sustainable company, CDL has established ambitious SBTi-validated 1.5°C targets towards net zero and put in place a rigorous action plan to achieve these targets. We look forward to supporting CDL and gaining more insights into their transition strategies and progress on their targets going forward. As the low-carbon race intensifies and more companies chart out their net-zero journeys, we stand ready to support their decarbonisation ambitions. After all, the only viable way for us to reach net zero in our financed emissions is for our clients to reach net zero in their emissions."

The OCBC 1.5°C loan reflects OCBC's longstanding commitment to support its customers on their net-zero journeys. The insights gained from working with corporates that take up the OCBC 1.5°C loan will help the Bank better support their transition plans with suitable advisory and financing solutions.

Since 2015, CDL has established a Climate Change Policy and set climate-related targets in 2017 to mitigate its environmental impact. Over the years, it has continued to transition towards net-zero and refine these targets in line with its corporate commitments towards climate action. In 2021, CDL was the first real estate developer in Singapore and the first real estate conglomerate in Southeast Asia to sign the WorldGBC's Net Zero Carbon Buildings Commitment.

With this latest 1.5°C loan, CDL has secured around S\$6 billion of sustainable financing in the form of a green bond, various green loans and sustainability-linked loans to date, starting with <u>its launch of the first green bond by a Singapore company in 2017.</u>

CDL Kicks Off Maiden Build-To-Rent Project In Australia

Construction is underway on CDL Australia's first build-to-rent project in Australia, which is set to bring more than 237 new units to Melbourne's Southbank. The groundbreaking ceremony at the Normanby Road development site marks the commencement of works by Crema Construction on the Hayball-designed BTR project, slated for completion in 2025.

"It is very exciting to see our vision for this wholly-owned BTR project in Melbourne start to take shape. "Following the construction sign-off, demolition was completed in September, making way for the commencement of piling and our official ground-breaking ceremony this month," said Mr Cameron Laird, head of development at CDL Australia.


The project will include a range of apartment sizes, including studios, one- and two-bedroom apartments. Amenities will include a mix of health and wellness facilities, podcast rooms, cinema room, outdoor BBQ terrace and collaborative working spaces.

"Normanby has been designed with a modern lifestyle in mind, and in a thriving location that is only two kilometres from Melbourne's CBD. As more and more young professionals switch to remote working arrangements, we have also included co-working areas so residents can work from home in a dedicated space, or students can easily collaborate together," said Mr Laird.

The Southbank project is the first of two BTR projects in the pipeline for CDL's subsidiary in Australia. The second development planned is a 320-plus apartment project in Brisbane's inner west suburb of Toowong.

CDL Australia has also recently commenced works on a second build-to-sell project, Fitzroy Fitzroy. Earlier in October, the group announced its \$130 million residential development, Brickworks Park, saw 95% of construction waste from demolition at the former Newmarket Brickworks site declared recyclable.

Forbes Asia Names Chairman Kwek 'Philanthropy Hero'

He is the sole Singaporean on the prestigious list.

Hong Leong Group Executive Chairman Mr Kwek Leng Beng is named a philanthropy hero by Forbes Asia for his joint S\$24 million donation with City Developments Limited (CDL), to the Singapore Institute of Technology (SIT). The endowed gift was witnessed by Emeritus Senior Minister Mr Goh Chok Tong (left) when the Mr Kwek announced it at the recent launch of his biography. Hong Leong Group Executive Chairman Mr Kwek Leng Beng has made it to the 17th edition of Forbes Asia's annual list 'Heroes of Philanthropy' in 2023. He is the only Singaporean on this year's list that spotlights 15 philanthropists from the Asia Pacific region who have in the past year shown commitment and donated generously to causes close to their hearts.

Mr Kwek announced an endowed gift of S\$24 million, jointly made by him and CDL, to the Singapore Institute of Technology (SIT) at the launch of his biography last month in November.

With an enhanced matching grant from the Singapore Government, the total endowment contribution amounts to S\$60 million that will help fund the construction of the university's administrative building, named the 'Kwek Leng Beng University Tower' at its future campus in the Punggol township in northeastern Singapore.

Earlier this year, Mr Kwek donated S\$720,000 to SIT to start six new academic initiatives, including bursaries and scholarships for SIT Hospitality Business undergraduates.



In appreciation of Mr Kwek's endowed gift, SIT will name its new University Tower at its future campus in Punggol, the Kwek Leng Beng University Tower. It is presented in a masterful replica of the 10-storey building made of 5,500 Lego pieces put together by 10 students and took more than 120-man hours to complete.



"Through this SIT donation, I am privileged to play a part in building future generations of talents and professionals for Singapore, especially in hospitality," said Mr Kwek in a statement revealing the gift. Mr Kwek is also the Executive Chairman of CDL.

Kwek's passion for hotels started five decades ago when he built the company's first hotel, the King's Hotel, which has been renamed Copthorne King's Hotel, near Singapore River on Havelock Road. City Developments has since grown to become one of Asia's largest hospitality operators with a global network of over 155 hotels, and owns iconic office buildings such as the Republic Plaza skyscraper in Singapore's central business district. It's the city-state's top developer by revenue.

Gatwick Diamond Business, a business community association in Gatwick, London, says thanks to Copthorne Effingham Park Hotel for their efforts to care for Afghan refugees for over two years, and welcomes the hotel's coming reopening to the public in January 2024.

Under the UK Government's Afghan Resettlement Programme, Copthorne Hotel Effingham Park in Gatwick, London has been temporarily housing Afghanistan refugees who fled to the UK due to the Taliban uprising in August 2021. The hotel has been helping the refugees settle into life in the UK.

As the programme comes to an end with almost all families found permanent homes, the hotel is gearing up to welcoming back tourists and businesses. Hotel Manager Mr Torsten Puck shares more on the hotel's humanitarian journey, culminating in its re-introduction to the Gatwick business community as it prepares to reopen its doors on 8 January 2024.

Copthorne Effingham Park's Millennium Suite was recently selected for a Members Meeting of the Gatwick Diamond Business (GDB), a business community association around and beyond the manor royal district reaching from London to Brighton.

Mr Raj Singh, Cluster General of Copthorne Effingham Park, Copthorne Gatwick Hotel and Copthorne Hotel Manchester who introduced the re-opening of the Hotel to 125 present businesses in a short but concise speech at the beginning of the event.

The Copthorne Hotel Effingham Park had not been trading publicly since the pandemic starting in 2020. There was a short re-opening time in between lockdowns but the hotel soon entered a government agreement, by providing legally required quarantine to travellers entering the United Kingdom from Red List Countries*.

As other hotels continued to operate to the general public after the ease of lockdowns, Copthorne Hotel Effingham Park remained under government acquisition to house refugees.

The cohort accommodated at the hotel had assisted the allied freedom forces in Afghanistan during an anti-terrorist operation and were removed before extremist organisations could seize control of the country after the scheduled retreat.

The UK Home Office, local authorities, and the hotel team have worked since to great efforts in order to integrate the traumatised people to the way of live in the UK. The Programme is now coming to an end as nearly all families have been found a permanent home, releasing the hotel from its humanitarian mission.

With the GDB Members Meeting, as one of the first corporate events in the re-decorated Millennium Conference Centre, the largest event hall between London and Brighton, we have been given the opportunity to present our abilities not only to hold large events but to succeed in customer service excellence.
